Mohanji's Message

Many people have poverty consciousness at some point in their lives—whether in this life or another. They experience poverty, and because of that, they cling to money or material things. You can see this clearly. They never experience abundance because they don't allow themselves to experience it. Their poverty consciousness prevents them from doing so.

So, how we perceive the world shapes how our world becomes. We can choose to perceive the world as an emperor would.

As I told you the story of Shivaji Maharaj, he was under great stress because he had to rule the kingdom. His mother asked him, "Why are you stressed?" He replied, "I have a big responsibility. I have to run this country."

She told him, "Then go to your Guru and give him what is most precious to you." So he went to his Guru and offered him the kingdom. The Guru said, "Okay, I accept it. Now, you run it."

What happened there? The Guru took the ownership and made the same king a custodian. After that, he became a super emperor. As soon as the sense of ownership was gone, he became powerful. What was bothering him and weighing him down was the idea of ownership — "I have to do it. This is mine. That is mine." That mindset was restricting and suffocating him.

The moment ownership was gone, he became powerful. The rest is history.

So how we see ourselves and how we perceive things shapes our world and our reality. But is that the ultimate reality? No. That is not the ultimate reality. The ultimate reality is much larger, much more meaningful, much deeper, and far more profound.

Know your Acharya

Since I connected with Mohanji in 2010, I have been fully engrossed in the purpose of serving the world and personally finding the permanent truth. Many people are surprised when they learn that, alongside my work and service-oriented life, I am also a mother of two adult sons. My older son, Filip, is 28, married, and Vukasin is 23. Having a fully committed role as a mother hasn't stopped me from seeking the ultimate fulfilment – self-realisation and liberation.

Over the years, I have consciously chosen to invest my time and skills in what feels meaningful and lasting. I am naturally drawn to activities that uplift – either myself or others through my work. As a result, I gradually lost interest in things that feel temporary or superficial, and instead focused on ways to live with purpose while honouring all my roles.

Six years ago, when the Himalayan School of Traditional Dance was founded, I became its global member and later also a Bharatanatyam dancer. I started by editing videos, and gradually became fully into it. My Bharatanatyam skills and presence have grown significantly. Recently, I have met the Indian Ambassador, Mr Abishek Shukla, an encounter far beyond anything I once imagined possible. Dance is my passion, and my body allows me to dance lightly and with agility, like a girl, which I am tremendously grateful for.

What many people do not know about me is that I used to be an autistic-like chronic introvert. Speaking often felt like a struggle. Through years of inner work, service, and discipline, this gradually transformed. Now I can speak freely and coherently. This is a transformation that cannot be learnt from the books – it grows with persistence, sincerity and life experience.

Passion for teaching is an important part of my life. I work with 120 kids every day and, through teaching English, I play a significant part in shaping the way they see the world – to connect to themselves, be happy, kind, and responsible. While making lessons appealing through stories, songs, dance and games, learning becomes an experience that stays with them – something they feel, not just memorise. Once, one group told me, “Bilja, when you are not here, we play ‘You’”. They loved the activities so much that they continued learning during their playtime – even assigning “Bilja” as a role in their games.

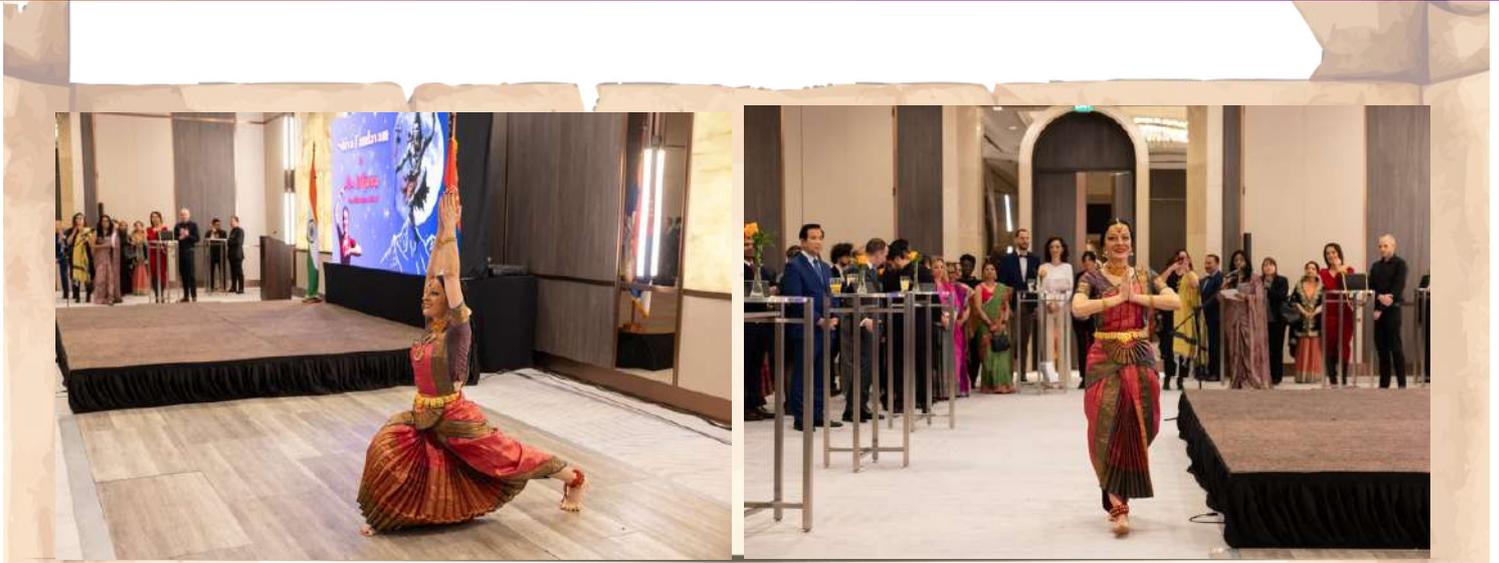
Another passion, writing poems, found a new direction – poems for meaningful occasions offering solace, clarity, or encouragement when it is most needed.

All my passions have found a place in service for the betterment of the world. And yet, the source of that service is deeply internal. It is not activity that defines me, but alignment. Not movement, but inner connection.

If I were given a day with no responsibilities, I would choose silence.

A complete digital detox. No distractions. No gadgets, travel or prosaic entertainment. I would sit in silence, chant within and fast on liquids or light, mild food. I would spend this day fully immersed in Mohanji's consciousness. That, for me, is the highest bliss.

I was born and raised in India and moved to the United States in 2006. I hold a Master's degree in Statistics and currently work as a Lead Statistical Programmer.

Witnessing the selfless service, compassion, and dedication of people on this path deeply touched my heart. I felt a sincere calling to share the same light, guidance, and support with others. Becoming an Acharya was not a decision of the mind, but a heartfelt response to an inner calling to serve.

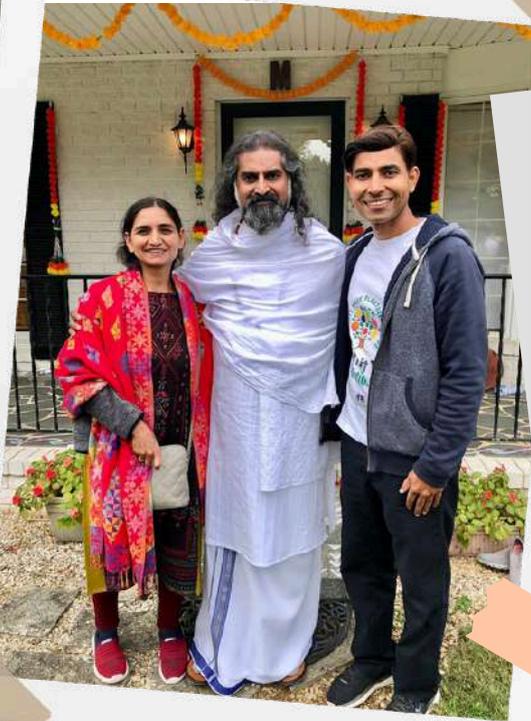

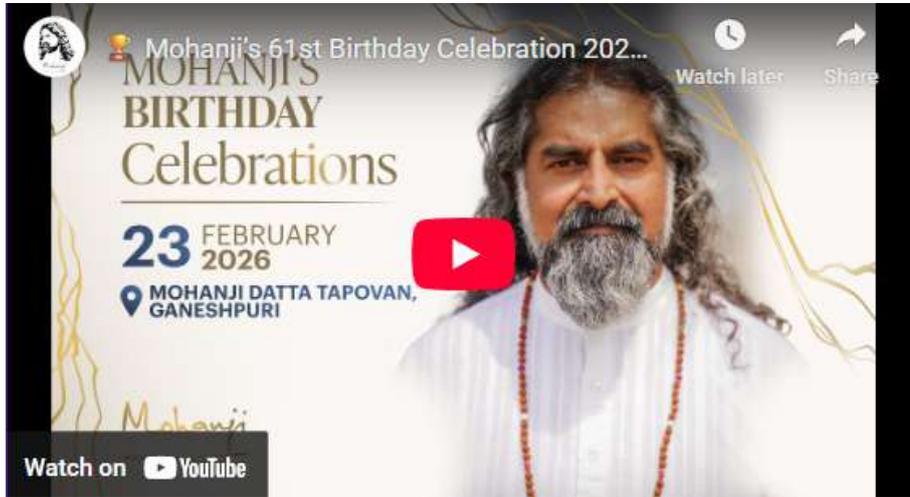
With gratitude in my heart, I surrender this journey at Mohanji's feet and remain committed to walking the path of awareness, service, and self-discovery.



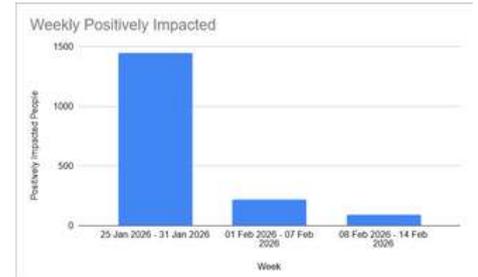
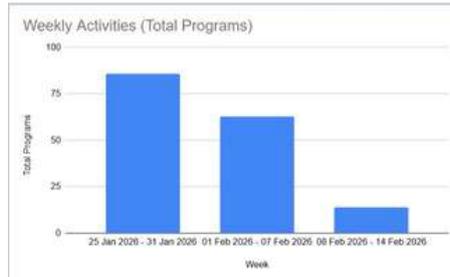
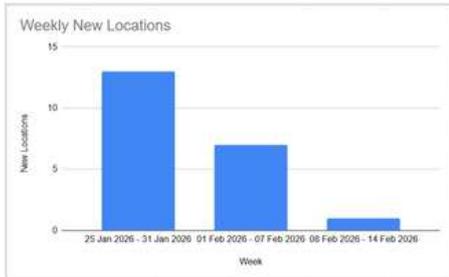
